 (3) Your 1993 New York adjusted gross income (NYAGI) is more than \$75,000 (more than \$37,500 if married filing separately), **and**
 (4) Your 1993 modified NYAGI exceeds your 1992 NYAGI by more than \$40,000 (more than \$20,000 if married filing separately), **and**
- C** All conditions in box B apply to you **except** condition (4), and your 1993 NYAGI exceeds your 1992 NYAGI by more than \$40,000 (more than \$20,000 if married filing separately). If you check this box, you must also attach a computation of your 1993 modified NYAGI.
- D** One or more of your required installments (line 14) is based on your 1992 tax and you filed or are filing a joint return for either 1992 or 1993, but not for both years.
- (5) Your 2nd, 3rd, or 4th required installment (column (b), (c), or (d) of line 14) is based on **either** your 1992 tax or 90% of your 1993 **modified** tax.
